Project EnergyConnect has reached a significant milestone as the first of five massive 374-tonne Phase Shifting Transformers finally arrived in Buronga, NSW. The enormous piece of kit started its long journey in Korea and travelled thousands of kilometres by sea to Australia where it was loaded onto a massive 128-wheel trailer to continue its 900km trek through two states and the outback.
