

# Powering Sydney's Future

## POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

### Cable bridge at Muir Road, Chullora

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. Work to construct a bridge for the new cable over the railway cutting at **Muir Road, Chullora** is due to start on **Monday 24 August 2020** and will take around three months, weather and ground conditions permitting.

We will set up two site compounds next to Muir Road, on either side of Anzac Street. The eastern site compound will include an area of the parking lane (see map overleaf).

#### Work activities

The work will involve:

- > installing temporary fencing and safety barriers around the site compounds
- > delivery and installation of drilling equipment and conduits (pipes to hold the cable)
- > installing pre-cast concrete piers and spans for the new bridge using a crane
- > constructing permanent safety barriers on the bridge
- > restoring impacted areas once the work is complete.

We will keep you updated on specific work activities throughout the bridge construction.

#### Work hours

Standard work hours are **7am – 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am – 1pm on Saturdays**. There may be some work outside these hours, including night time deliveries of oversized equipment, to minimise impacts on traffic and meet road safety requirements.

#### How will the work affect you?

- > The work will generate some noise, which we will make every effort to keep to a minimum.
- > There will be a temporary loss of street parking while work is in progress.
- > There will be temporary lane closures to ensure the safety of workers and road users. Traffic control will be in place to safely direct traffic around the site.
- > Access to properties will be maintained.
