## POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

### Night time traffic change on May Street to temporarily affect access to Hutchinson Street, Lackey Street and Applebee Street, St Peters

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. We thank you for your patience during recent trenching work on May Street and Princes Highway.

**From Tuesday 15 June, night work will continue on Princes Highway near the May Street intersection.** We will work five nights each week, Sunday night to Thursday night, from 7pm to 6am each night. This work is expected to take around three weeks to complete (weather and ground conditions permitting).

During night work, May Street will be closed to westbound traffic at its intersection with the Princes Highway. This will temporarily affect access to Hutchinson Street, Lackey Street and Applebee Street for residents travelling southbound on King Street (Princes Highway). Please refer to the map overleaf for available detour routes.

### Traffic changes Sunday night to Thursday night, 7pm to 6am

- > May Street will be closed to westbound traffic at its intersection with Princes Highway. There will be no access into May Street from Princes Highway.
- > Eastbound traffic on May Street will be maintained under traffic control at the intersection with Princes Highway.
- > Two-way traffic will be maintained on Princes Highway under traffic control. Please expect short delays.
- > **Access to Hutchinson Street, Applebee Street and Lackey Street from King Street (Princes Highway) southbound:**
  - Detour 1:  
From King Street / Princes Highway southbound, use the turning loop at Barwon Park Road to turn back onto Princes Highway northbound. Then, turn left into Goodsell Street, left into Council Street, right into May Street, left into Campbell Street and left into Hutchison Street.
  - Detour 2:  
Continue south on King Street / Princes Highway, turn right into Campbell Street, continue over the Bedwin Road bridge and turn left into Edinburgh Road. Use the roundabout on Edinburgh Road to turn back into Bedwin Road, then continue on to Campbell Street and then left into Hutchison Street.
- > There will be a temporary loss of parking on Princes Highway and May Street (day and night).

Please note: May Street will be open to westbound traffic at the Princes Highway intersection outside our work hours.

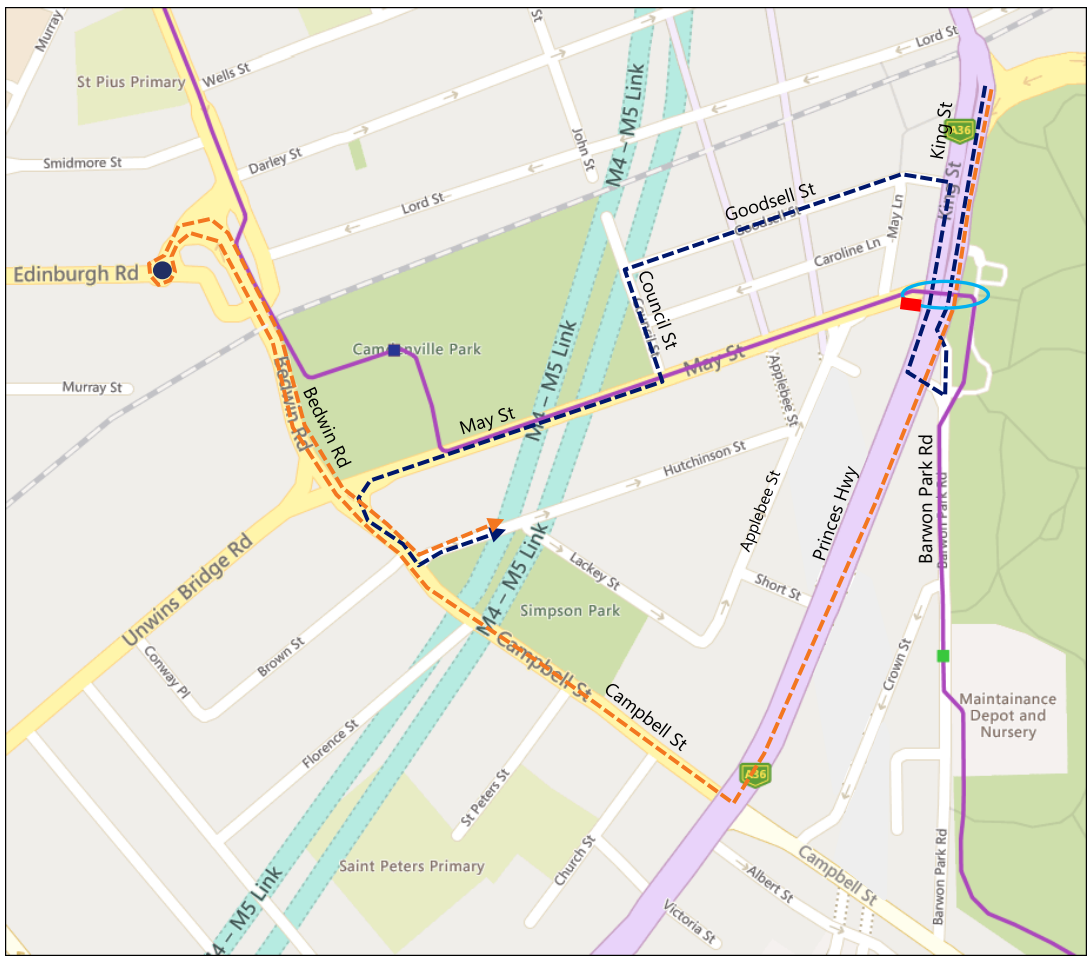
