POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT

Work to install a new underground 330kV electricity cable between Potts Hill and Alexandria is almost completed in your area.

This newsletter is to update you on plans for permanent restoration of roads in the City of Canterbury Bankstown.

The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas.

You may have noticed that most of our construction work in your area has been completed and the road surface excavated for the project has been temporarily restored to allow normal traffic flow.

Permanent restoration of the road surface is beginning as the new cable is tested.

TransGrid has arranged to pay the City of Canterbury Bankstown to do permanent restoration of local roads on our behalf.

Road restoration starting soon

Council is planning to start permanent road restoration from Sunday 25 July 2021 (weather permitting). This work will start at Hillcrest Avenue in Greenacre, which is the first local road at the western end of our project route. Work crews will progressively work along roads on the cable route towards the eastern end of the project route within Council's area.

Residents and businesses in the vicinity of this work will receive notification from Council (or its contractor) at least 48 hours before road restoration begins.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation during construction and for the feedback we have received during the project.

How will work affect you?

- Road restoration is typically done at night.
- There will be temporary restrictions on street parking while the work is done.
- Traffic management will be in place for the safety of the community and the work crew.
- The work will be noisy at times.
- Keep an eye out for a notification from the City of Canterbury Bankstown with more information about the work.
