Opportunity for non-network alternatives to a major transmission network upgrade on the Far North Coast of New South Wales

TransGrid is a transmission network service provider responsible for the operation and management of the majority of the NSW high voltage transmission network. TransGrid is currently developing its plans for a major transmission network upgrade to meet the needs of the NSW Far North Coast load area.

This Request for Proposals (RFP) seeks proposals for non-network solutions from potential service providers for the Far North Coast area for summer in years 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14 and 2014/15.

The RFP documents provide the necessary technical and commercial details and include a Response Form and a pro-forma Network Support Agreement.

To be eligible for consideration proponents must offer a minimum of 5MW of capacity support to TransGrid. Eligible non-network alternatives may include, but are not limited to, embedded generation and demand response initiatives.
