POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Out-of-hours trenching work at Rookwood Road and Muir Road, Chullora

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. Trenching work at **Rookwood Road and Muir Road, Chullora** will start from **Friday, 2 October 2020**. The work is expected to progress at around 30 metres per shift, weather and ground conditions permitting. These works need to be completed outside of standard construction hours due to high daytime traffic volumes.

Work activities

- > Cutting the road surface with a concrete saw.
- > Digging a trench about two metres wide using an excavator.
- > Installing conduits (pipes) in the trench.
- > Backfilling the trench and covering it with steel plates.
- > Temporarily and permanent restoration the road surface to allow normal traffic flow.

Our team will return to permanently restore any outstanding sections at a later date after the new cable has been installed.

Work hours

Out-of-hours work will be carried out from 7pm to 5am from Friday, 2 October to Tuesday, 6 October over the October long weekend.

How will the work affect you?

- > Muir Road will be closed westbound to all traffic, and access to Muir Road will be restricted from Rookwood Road northbound.
- > No right-hand turn from Rookwood Road into Muir Road.
- > No right-hand turn on the northern side of Dasea Street roundabout.
- > No left-hand turn from the southern side of the Dasea Street roundabout.
- > No left-hand turn from the southern side of the Elcar Place roundabout.
- > Access in will be from Rookwood Road with left out south via Muir Road.
- > The work will generate some noise, which we will make every effort to keep to a minimum.
- > There will be a temporary loss of street parking between Dasea Street and Elcar Place while works are in progress.


