~~Following requests from community members and landowners for additional time, Transgrid has extended the consultation period for five weeks until Friday, September 8.~~

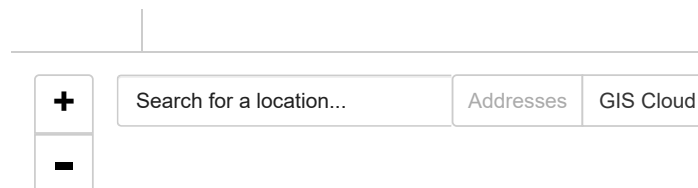

This interactive map shows the preferred corridor for VNI West along with some of the key constraints considered during the preparation of the Draft Corridor Report. Constraint layers can be turned on or off using the map menu. This includes highly constrained areas which need to be avoided, along with additional technical, environmental and social constraints which have been considered.

Landholders can also search for their properties using the address search, or the map zoom function.
