POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT
COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Preliminary works at Camdenville Park, St Peters

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. You can view a map of the cable route at www.transgrid.com.au/psf.

Work to install temporary fencing and hoarding in Camdenville Park, adjacent to the rail corridor will take place during a pre-existing planned rail power outage on **Saturday, 31 October 2020**. This work is needed to protect workers during future works to construct a cable bridge adjacent to Bedwin Road Bridge. A map of the work location is included overleaf.

Work activities

Activities on site:

- > Delivery of a five-tonne excavator to Camdenville Park.
- > Clearing and grubbing of vegetation on the southern side of the new cable bridge.
- > Installing temporary fencing and a plywood hoarding around de-energised above ground power cables.

Plant and equipment used will include:

- > An excavator.
- > A delivery truck and lighter work vehicles.
- > Hand tools.

Work hours

Work will be undertaken during standard work hours from 8am – 1pm, on Saturday, 31 October.

How will the work affect you?

- > These works will involve an increase in construction vehicles to and from the site.
- > These works will generate some noise. However, our crews will seek to limit these impacts as much as possible.
- > Intermittent noise may be heard from the site during pick up and laydown of equipment.
