# Permanent road restoration at Rookwood Road, Yagoona

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. As outlined in our letter to you on 22 June 2021, we are returning to Rookwood Road to permanently restore the road surface. We had planned to restart on 29 July. However, our plan to restart was delayed slightly longer than expected, and then impacted further by the pause on construction work in accordance with the NSW Government's COVID-19 Public Health Order.

The construction crew will return to restart work from **Wednesday 29 September** and will be working at night when traffic volumes are lower. The work will take place over a **three week period** but will not be continuous:

- Stage 1, involving laying new asphalt on the road surface, will take around one week to complete.
- Stage 2, involving line marking the road surface, will take place when the new road surface has had time to dry and is expected to take **two days** to complete.

### Work activities

#### Stage 1:

- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Removing a layer of the existing road surface using a profiler.
- > Laying new asphalt on the road pavement.
- > Compacting the road surface using a roller.

# Stage 2:

- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Using a road sweeper to clean the road surface.
- > Line marking the road surface.

#### **Work hours**

Night work hours are 6pm to 6am, Monday to Saturday.

# How will the work affect you?

- > Two-way traffic on Rookwood Road will be maintained under a stop/slow traffic setup when work is in progress. Traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users.
- > The work will be noisy at times, but we will make every effort to keep noise to a minimum.
- > Road users may experience short delays to access local properties.
- > If we expect your driveway access will be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and discuss arrangements.
