

## **About HumeLink East**

HumeLink will deliver cheaper and more reliable power for consumers by increasing the amount of renewable energy that can be delivered across the national electricity grid. The project will create more than 1600 jobs and generate major benefits, including employment opportunities and community investment, for local communities along the route.

Transgrid has contracted Acciona Construction Australia Pty Ltd and Genus Infrastructure (NSW) Pty Ltd to deliver the eastern portion of the HumeLink project, known as HumeLink East.

HumeLink East involves expanding the existing Bannaby 500 kV substation, and the design and construction of a 500 kV double circuit transmission line. This new transmission line will connect the Bannaby 500 kV substation at the Wondalga interface point with HumeLink West.
