Powering Sydney's Future

POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Underbore at Sydney Park, Alexandria

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. You can view a map of the cable route at www.transgrid.com.au/psf

Work to drill an underbore at Sydney Park, Alexandria, is due to start from **Wednesday**, **27 January 2021** and will take around five weeks to complete, weather and ground conditions permitting.

We will set up three work areas: one compound in Sydney Park for storing and welding pipes; one in Harber Street car park; and one in a private property on Euston Road. Please refer to the map overleaf for the location of the underbore works areas.

Work activities

- > Installing temporary fencing and safety barriers.
- > Trimming trees to create a safe distance from plant and equipment (conducted by a trained arborist).
- > Excavating a pit 6m x 1.5m in Harber St car park and in the private property on Euston Rd.
- > Drilling under the road using a drill rig located in the private property on Euston Rd.
- > Assembling and then pulling conduits (plastic pipes) through the underbore.
- > Digging a trench about two metres wide using an excavator and installing conduits (pipes) in the trench.
- > Temporarily restoring the work area.

Permanent restoration and line marking of the carpark and any impacted areas will take place after the new cable has been pulled through and tested. We will write to you again before these next stages of work.

Work hours

> Work hours are Monday to Sunday 7am to 6pm.

How will the work affect you?

- > The work will be noisy at times, but every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum.
- > There will be a temporary loss of approximately five car spaces within the Harber Street car park at Sydney Park while work is in progress.
- > Road users may experience short delays to access local properties. Traffic control will be in place to safely direct traffic around the site. Resident access to car parking and garages at the rear of Campbell Road will generally be maintained. If we expect your garage access will be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and discuss arrangements. If parking spaces at the rear of property are to be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and arrange for parking in the Harber Street car park.


