Work Notification | January 2025 Traffic camera installation. Tarcutta

HumeLink is one of Australia's largest energy infrastructure projects connecting renewable energy sources to the grid and helping to put downward pressure on energy prices. The project consists of 365 kilometres of 500 kV overhead transmission lines connecting Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle and is being delivered in two sections.

The section between Wagga Wagga, Maragle and Wondalga is being constructed by UGL Engineering and CPB Contractors, working in joint venture as the HumeLink West JV.

#### About the work

We have started enabling work to establish access points and tracks, which will be used during construction of the transmission lines, and to prepare for construction of the Tarcutta accommodation facility and compound.

To monitor our work activities and impacts, we will be installing and operating a trailer-mounted CCTV camera on Mates Gully Road at the intersection of Sydney Street, Tarcutta from **Monday 3 February 2025**.

The purpose of the CCTV camera is for traffic counts, and it will not be used as a surveillance device, or to acquire or store any personal information.

### What you can expect

The CCTV camera will be in operation intermittently for short periods during HumeLink West construction over the next two years. The camera will record traffic counts for vehicles on Mates Gully Road, Sydney Street and Hume Highway off-ramp.

## When we are working

Work to install, maintain and relocate the camera will take place during standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. If work out of these hours is required, we will contact you at least seven days before the work starts.

#### Where we will be working

The trailer-mounted CCTV camera will be located at the intersection of Mates Gully Road and Sydney Street, Tarcutta, shown in the map over the page.
