POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Out-of-hours construction of cable bridge at Muir Road, Chullora

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable energy supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. You can view a map of the cable route at www.transgrid.com.au/psf.

Out-of-hours work for the new cable bridge at **Muir Road**, **Chullora** will start on **Friday**, **9 October 2020**. These works need to be completed outside of standard construction hours due to high daytime traffic volumes.

Work activities

- > Delivery of precast beams.
- > Preparing precast beams for lifting on the side of Muir Road.
- > Setting up a 500-tonne mobile crane near the intersection of Anzac Street and Muir Road.
- > Lifting and installing six 30m long precast beams.

The crane will swing away from Muir Road toward the new bridge and shall not operate at any time over live traffic.

Work hours

Out-of-hours work will be carried out from 3am to 5am on Friday, 9 October and from 8pm Saturday, 10 October to 1pm Sunday, 11 October.

How will the work affect you?

- > A temporary contraflow on Muir Road will divert westbound traffic around the work area.
- > Traffic control will be in place to safely direct traffic around the site.
- > Crane operations can generate noise, which we will make every effort to keep to a minimum.
- > Access to properties will be maintained unless we make alternative arrangements with you in advance.
- > There will be a temporary loss of street parking while work is in progress.
- > There will be temporary lane closures to ensure the safety of workers and road users.
