POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

## Permanent road restoration at Old Canterbury Road, Ashfield / Dulwich Hill

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. This letter is to advise you of permanent road restoration work on **Old Canterbury Road**, **Ashfield**, which will be the final stage of work. Thank you for your patience throughout the project.

This work is expected to take three days and will be done between Wednesday 22 September 2021 and early October 2021, weather and COVID-19 health restrictions permitting. There will be traffic changes during the work as shown on the map overleaf.

#### **Work activities**

- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Grinding a layer off the existing road surface before the new surface is laid.
- > Laying new asphalt on the road.
- > Compacting the road surface using a roller.
- > Using a road sweeper to clean the road surface.
- > Marking the road with new lines.

### Work hours

Work hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.

## How will the work affect you?

- > Traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users.
- > Two-way traffic on Old Canterbury Road will be maintained under stop/slow arrangements.
- > At times Arlington St, Prospect Rd, Hanks St, Cobar St, Elizabeth Ave, Hugh Ave will be closed at Old Canterbury Road. Access for residents will be maintained via Queen St, Hurlstone Ave, Arlington St or Dixson Ave
- > The work will be loud at times, but we will make every effort to keep noise to a minimum. The loudest activity will be when the machine grinding the road surface is operating for part of the work period.
- > There may be temporary closures of footpaths but we will provide an alternative route.
- > Road users may experience short delays to access local properties.






