POTTS HILL TO ALEXANDRIA TRANSMISSION CABLE PROJECT

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Investigation night work at Centennial Street and Sydenham Road, Marrickville

TransGrid is installing a new underground electricity cable from Potts Hill to Alexandria. The Powering Sydney's Future project will help ensure a safe, reliable and affordable electricity supply for Sydney's CBD and surrounding areas. Before starting the cable installation process, we need to accurately locate existing underground utilities on Sydenham Road around the intersection with Centennial Street. This work will start from **Friday 9 April 2021** and is expected to take **up to one week** to complete, weather and ground conditions permitting. It will involve digging small holes and short trenches of around 10 metres long at the intersection as shown on the map overleaf.

This work needs to be done outside standard construction hours due to high daytime traffic volumes.

Work activities

The investigations will involve:

- > Delivering plant and equipment to site.
- > Tree trimming to create a safe distance from plant and equipment (conducted by a trained arborist).
- > Cutting the road surface with a concrete saw.
- > Digging small holes and short trenches in the road.
- > Using a dewatering pump/vacuum truck as required.
- > Temporarily restoring the road to allow normal traffic flow.

Work hours

Work hours are 6pm to 6am, Monday to Sunday.

How will the works affect you?

- Centennial Street, Centennial Lane and Boland Lane will be temporarily closed to through traffic during the work. Detours for vehicles and traffic control will be in place for the safety of workers and road users. Centennial Street, Centennial Lane and Boland Lane will remain open to local residents under traffic control.
- Sydenham Road, near the Centennial Street intersection, will be open to traffic but under stop/slow conditions. Please allow extra time to travel through this intersection during the work.
- > The work will be noisy at times, but every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum. We aim to complete high impact noise activities before midnight on each shift wherever possible.
- > There will be a temporary loss of street parking of around 100 metres while the work is in progress.
- > Road users may experience short delays to access local properties.
- > There may be temporary closures of footpaths, but we will provide an alternative route for pedestrians.
- > If we expect your driveway access will be disrupted, we will inform you in advance and discuss arrangements.



What's next

We expect to be working on Sydenham Road and Centennial Street until June 2021 but work will not be continuous during this period.

Following the investigation work, we will return to the highlighted work area on Sydenham Road, between Centennial Street and Neville Street, to dig the trench for the new transmission cable. This work is expected to be done over one weekend in April, with a second weekend scheduled if required to complete the work.

On Centennial Street, we will also need install and join cables at the recently installed joint bay, install a second joint bay and some minor ancillary pits, and temporarily restore the road surface.

You will receive further information before the next stages of work in the area.

Once all work is complete in the area and the cable is installed and tested, we will permanently restore the road surface.
